<b>Nature of matter:</b>	Sentence— The accused was convicted, on a plea of guilty of the murder of Mbulelo Boloti; robbery with aggravating circumstances; unlawful possession of a firearm in contravention of s3 of Act 60 of 2000 and unlawful possession of ammunition in contravention of s90 of the same Act. The prosecution accepted the plea of guilty, as also the factual basis upon which it was tendered as set out in a written statement furnished in terms of section 112 (2) of the Criminal Procedure Act, 51 of 1977.	
<b>Order:</b>	On the count of murder - 22 years imprisonment; On the count of robbery with aggravating circumstances, - 15 years imprisonment; On the count of unlawful possession of a firearm terms of s 3 of Act 60 of 2000 - 3 years imprisonment; On the count of unlawful possession of ammunition in contravention of s 90 of Act 60 of 2000 - 18 months imprisonment; It is ordered that the sentences imposed on each of the counts shall run concurrently.
