Nature of matter:	<p>The accused is charge with two counts of kidnapping, robbery, three counts of rape and pointing of anything which is likely to lead a person to believe it is a firearm.</p> <p>The accused pleaded not guilty to all counts. In his plea explanation he admitted having had consensual sexual intercourse with both complainants. The court held that the state has proved beyond reasonable doubt the charges against the accused</p>
