Exceptions – vague and embarrassing – requirements for such a finding.

*Tacit contract – conduct and circumstances giving rise to such contract must be pleaded – otherwise pleading vague and embarrassing.* 

*Rule 18(7)- distinction between tacit term of a contract and a tacit contract. Rule 18(7) only of application in first case.* 

Contract subject to a suspensive condition – pleading must state whether condition fulfilled in order to give rise to rights and obligations – failure to furnish this information makes pleading vague and embarrassing.
