APPLICATION FOR A TRANSFER OF AN INDIVIDUAL COMMERCIAL SOUND BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENCE FROM EAST COAST RADIO (PTY) LTD TO KAGISO BROADCASTING (PTY) LTD

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received an application from East Coast Radio (Pty) Ltd ("ECR"), for a transfer of its Individual Commercial Sound Broadcasting Service Licence lodged in terms of regulation 11 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences and Special Temporary Authorisations of 2010 read with sections 13(1) and (2) of the Electronic Communications Act, No 36 of 2005.

ECR must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person having made such written representations.
