## DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY

# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF CANDIDATES TO BE APPOINTED AS MEMBERS OF THE TAKEOVER REGULATION PANEL IN TERMS OF THE COMPANIES ACT, NO 71 OF 2008, AS AMENDED, ("the Act")

Section 196 of the Act establishes the Takeover Regulation Panel (TRP) as a juristic person to function as an organ of state but as an institution outside the public service. In compliance with the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Trade and Industry, Dr Rob Davies, hereby invites nominations of persons as candidates for appointment as members of TRP as contemplated in section 196 of the Act.

#### The Minister seeks to appoint seven (7) additional members:

- One person designated by an exchange named for the purpose by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.
- Six other persons appointed by the Minister on the basis of their knowledge and experience in the regulation
  of securities and takeovers.

#### Term of office for members of the TRP:

Members of the TRP will serve for a term of five (5) years as determined by the Minister at the time of appointment

### Nomination Procedure:

- Nominations or applications must be submitted in writing and must at least contain the following: detailed CV, motivation for appointment, certified copy of identity document, qualifications and declaration of interest form obtainable from the dti website to explain his or her suitability for appointment.
- A brief statement signed by the nominee in which he or she agrees to the nomination.
- Nominations are subject to the preferred candidates obtaining the necessary security clearance.
- Preference will be given to candidates whose appointment will enhance representivity.
- Background verification, including criminal record and citizenship checks, will form part of the selection process.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to have foreign qualifications verified by the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA).
- Correspondence will be limited to short-listed members only.
- No facsimile applications will be accepted.
